

TITLE I SERVICES

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Title I program provides students in Grades 4 and 5 with supplementary math tutoring designed to assist them to reach the challenging academic standards expected of all students. The program is funded by federal Title I Part A aid to education.

The goal of the project is to improve the Mathematics skills of participating students, to build their confidence as learners, and to encourage their enthusiasm to become lifelong learners.

ELIGIBILITY

Students are selected for participation based on a number of factors including:

- Standardized test scores
- Classroom assessments
- Teacher recommendation
- Progress report grades
- Academic Level
- Previous participation in Title I services
- Parent Permission
