

Ethnic Code Form

The following ethnic information is requested in order to fulfill state enrollment data.

A pupil may be included in the group to which he or she appears to belong, identifies with, or is regarded in the community as belonging to. No person should be counted in more than one racial/ethnic group category. Please write in the appropriate code for your child in the space provided.

The seven code definitions are:

Code 1- American Indian or Alaskan Native- A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

Code 2- Asian- A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent. This area includes, for example: China, India, Japan and Korea.

Code 3- Hispanic- A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South America, or other Spanish Culture or origin- regardless of race.

Code 4- Black (not of Hispanic Origin) - A person having origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa

Code 5- White (not of Hispanic Origin)- A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa or the Middle East.

Code 6- Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander- A person having origins from the Hawaiian Islands, Philippine Islands, and Samba.
